

## 20 things YOU can do to ensure success MFL

<p><b>1.</b> Rag rate the three topic areas:</p> <p>Identity and Culture / Local, national and international areas of interest / Current and future study and employment</p>	<p><b>2.</b> Choose one of your RED rag rated areas and make revision cards for at least 30 new words</p>	<p><b>3.</b> Use the vocabulary book available on Pupil Resources – choose a topic area and eliminate the words you already know.</p>	<p><b>4.</b> Use Memrise / Quizlet or GCSE Bitesize.</p> <p>Choose a different topic area every week.</p>	<p><b>5.</b> Modal verbs – use a variety of methods to learn these in all tenses and use past papers to identify them.</p>
<p><b>6.</b> Use past exam papers to identify different tenses. Use the transcripts for this in the Listening exams</p>	<p><b>7.</b> Make a set of 25 – 30 revision cards; English on one side and French/German on the other.</p> <p>Test yourself – get somebody else to test you</p>	<p><b>8.</b> Make a different set of 25 – 30 revision cards; one word per card.</p> <p>Put them face down and play the Memory game</p>	<p><b>9.</b> Make a different set of 25 – 30 revision cards; one word per card.</p> <p>Play speed matching.</p>	<p><b>10.</b> Make domino cards – divide cards in two, have English on one half and French/German on other half. Make a loop</p>
<p><b>11.</b> Hexagons – use the template in the shared area and make sets to match up.</p> <p>Share with somebody else in Year 11</p>	<p><b>12.</b> Knowledge Organisers – A4 split into 6/8 sections and fill in with new words for individual topic areas.</p>	<p><b>13.</b> LACAWAC- keep practising new vocabulary using the “folding” method. Ensure you use new vocabulary each time</p>	<p><b>14.</b> Download and complete past exam papers at least once a week – keep doing them even if you have done them before.</p> <p>Available on Pupil Resources</p>	<p><b>15.</b> Use purple GCSE workbooks and revision guides.</p> <p>Audio files for both available on Pupil Resources.</p>
<p><b>16.</b> Print out 25 – 30 words – pairwork learning with friends / family</p>	<p><b>17.</b> Mind maps – choose a topic area and categorise the words. Eg verbs / adjectives / nouns etc</p>	<p><b>18.</b> Use Spotify. Type in the kind of music you like listening to followed by français or Deutsch</p>	<p><b>19.</b> Posters / Post it Notes of examples of verbs in all the various tenses.</p>	<p><b>20.</b> Posters / Post it Notes of high frequency words and little words which make a big difference.</p>
