

## Year 10 mock exams. Essential equipment and reminders

Science - You will need a calculator for each exam

PE GCSE- You need to bring a pen and pencil and will need to have revised the following areas that they have covered so far:

Muscular & skeletal & movement analysis, Preventing injury in physical activity, Risk assessment, Health fitness and wellbeing, Cardiovascular & respiratory, Components of fitness, Principles of training, Diet & Nutrition

English – Pen and a pencil. Reminder that it is Paper 1 English Language and Paper 1 English Literature. (See Ms Bates' letter for more info) Some individual teachers have set up files in pupil resources – English resources – all pupils can access any of these resources.

Maths- Calculator, ruler, rubber, pencil, pen, compasses, protractor and brain.

RE- for the RE exam pupils only need a pen and a spare just in case.

Pupils have been given a checklist of topics to focus their revision on.

In pupil resources, re resources, year 10 folder there is a revision booklet with everything that they need to revise. They can download/print and make revision resources for anything that they aren't sure of.

DT - . For our RM/GP exams all pupils will need pens, pencils, rubbers, rulers, protractors and calculators. They will be answering some maths based questions as well as general D&T knowledge.

Computer Science - reminders that there are a wide range of revision resources in **Pupil Resources\Computing\KS4\Revision** folder. Also, that after school revision sessions start today in room 17 from 3.30 – 4.30pm each week until next May

Art - Make sure all sketchbook work is completed before the exam. As 75% of your mark will be based on this.

**Half term homework:** To create four design ideas that link to your artists and experiments.
