AO1: Artist Study. 18 marks

1. Confident ability to investigate.
 2. Perceptive annotations.
 3. Critical understanding of context & sources.
1. Ideas developed & inspired by source material.

AO2: Experiments. 18 marks.

1. Confident ability to refine work. Refinements driven by insights from explorations in AO1.
2. Ideas explored through a process of experimentation & review.
3. Techniques, materials, media & processes selected with thought to personal intentions.

This will be evidenced in your sketchbook.

AO3: Recording (drawing and annotation). 18 marks

1. Assured ability to record ideas, observations & insights.
2. Work is personal & relevant.

This will be evidenced in your sketchbook.

AO4: Outcomes. 18 marks.

1. Personal & meaningful response.
2. Ability to realise intentions with skill.
3. Confident understanding of visual language, demonstrated through use of the formal elements

This will be evidenced in your final piece. Exam work.
