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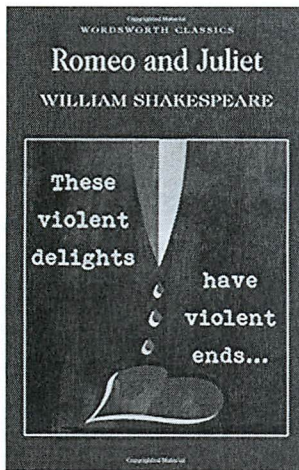
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Dear Parents/Carers

Successful literary critiquing often includes colour coding, margin annotations, folding over of pages and the use of multi coloured post its. As you can imagine, we cannot afford to purchase whole sets of texts, which could not be used in subsequent years.

When studying the Shakespeare play in class, it is easy to refer to acts, scenes and lines rather than page numbers, so we do not mind which version is purchased and we leave this to your own preferences. The text pictured below is popular and currently available on Amazon at a price of £2.00.
