Christmas trip to Lille and Ypres, December 2020

We are excited to be offering a French Christmas trip to Lille and Ypres next year for our current Y9 pupils choosing GCSE French as an option. This will be a unique opportunity to support the global aspirations of our school by immersing pupils in French culture and traditions and to create a unique bonding experience.

The key details about the planned trip are as follows:

- Three days, two nights
- Departs on Friday 11th December 2020
- Returns on Sunday 13th December 2020
- The group size is 40 pupils plus 3 members of staff
- · The cost is £260 per pupil

This price includes

- · Coach and Eurotunnel to and from France
- · Accommodation on a half board basis
- · School travel insurance
- All visits included in the itinerary

The itinerary for the trip will include the following:

- Lille's Christmas Markets:
 - Place Rihour; this is the main site for the Christmas Market where pupils will find over 80 chalets, Father Christmas and the Funfair.
 - La Grande Place; the giant 50 ft Ferris wheel is here along with more stalls and all year round shops. Crêperie; where we will take a break from the hustle and bustle for lunch!
- Overnight stay at a Hotel in Lille
- Cultural Trip to Boulogne Sightseeing in the old roman town and visit to Becasuc sweet factory.
- Ypres, Belgium For the second part of the trip, we will be heading across the border into Ypres, Belgium. This will give the pupils the opportunity to visit the World War I battlefields and museums along with the chance to retrace the footsteps of soldiers who fought in World War I. Overnight stay at a Hotel in Ypres

In addition to the cost of the trip, your child will need money to buy snacks en route, meals and souvenirs (suggested amount €100). They will also require a full valid passport and EHIC.

To secure a place for your son/daughter on this trip, a deposit of £60 is required, along with the completed permission slip below by Tuesday 11th February.

Before applying for the trip, please be aware of the following:

- if the trip is oversubscribed, we will draw names from all of the pupils who have paid deposits by the deadline
- any unsuccessful pupils will have their deposits returned.

• we also reserve the right to withdraw a pupil from the trip later on in the year if we have serious behaviour concerns.

The payment plan following the deposit, valid only for the pupils who will manage to secure a place on the trip, is outlined below. Each of the instalments following the deposit **will also be non-refundable** as they fall due.
