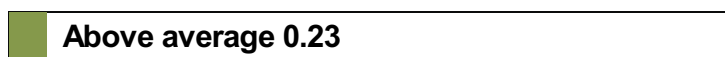

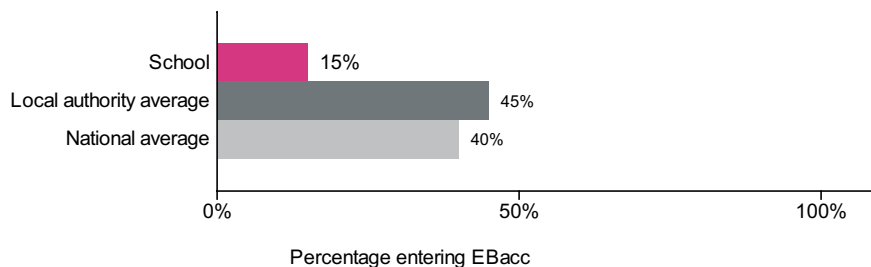

## Percentage entering English Baccalaureate

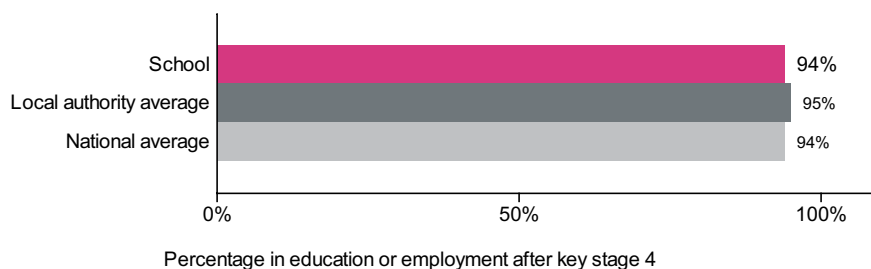

## Percentage staying in education or entering employment after key stage 4

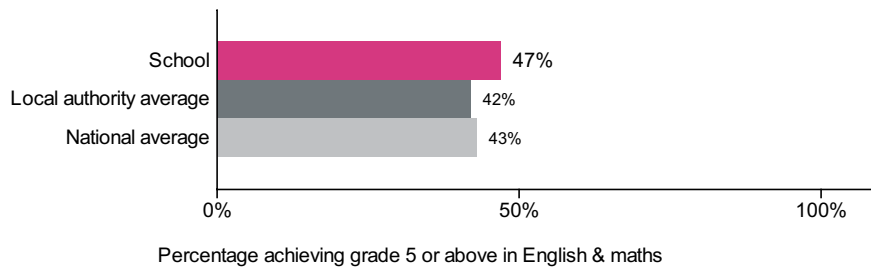

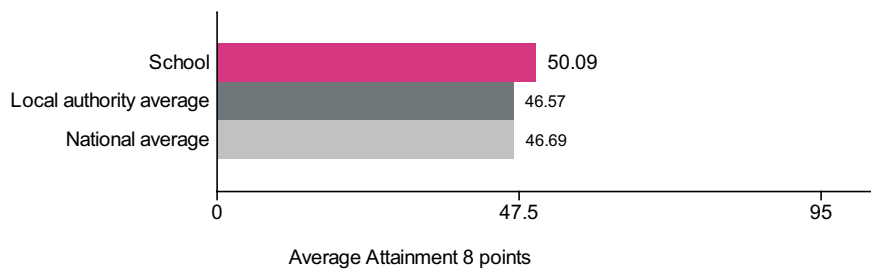
# Percentage achieving grade 5 or above in English and maths
